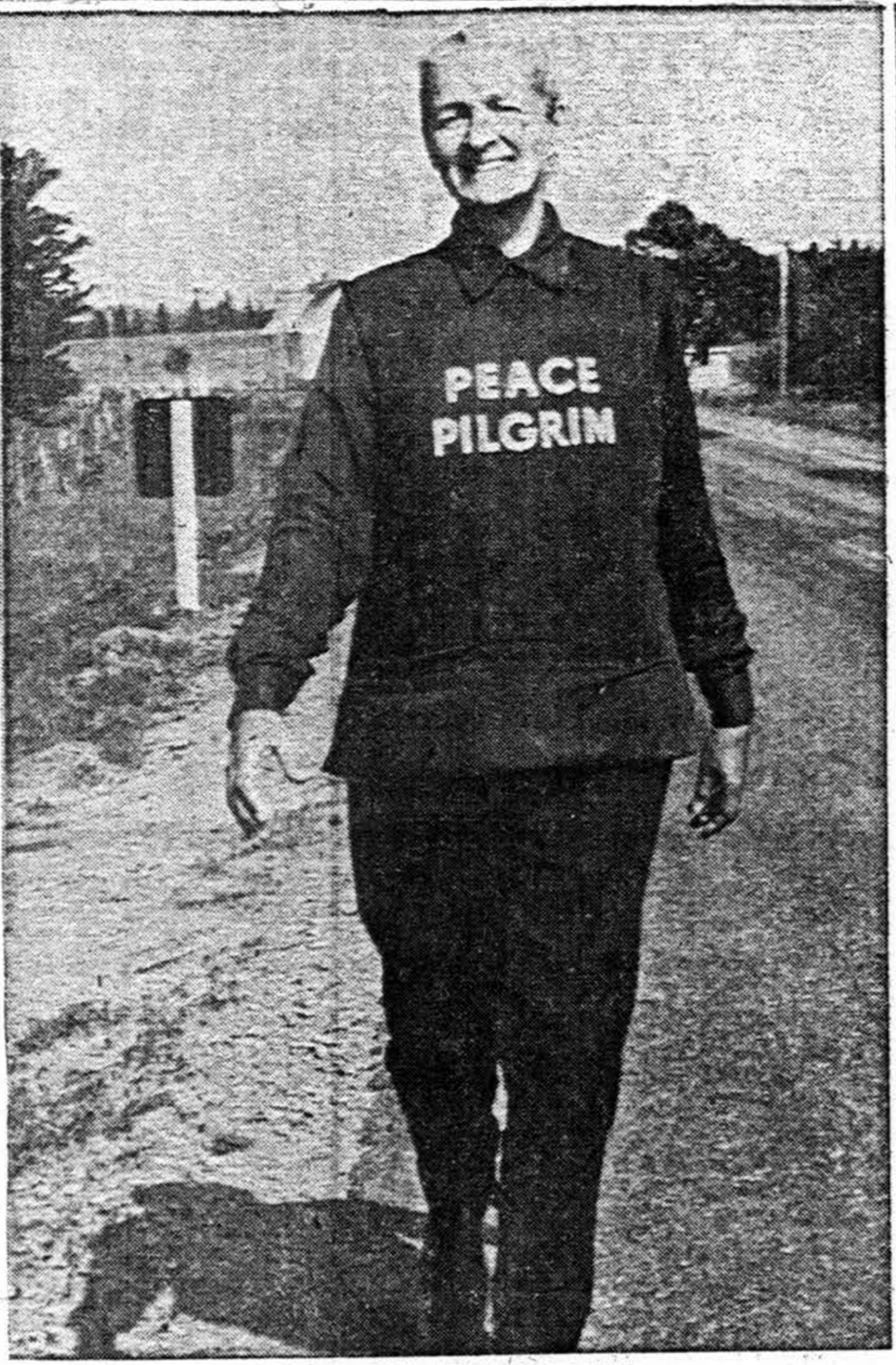


THE PRINCE EDWARD ISLANDER

Four and a half years ago she set out from Los Angeles with the objective of walking 10,000 miles for world peace. By now she will have walked 10,500 miles and proposes to walk 100 miles in each of the other Atlantic Provinces, Quebec and Ontario. She has already

walked 100 miles in the western provinces. She has also walked through the United States and Mexico.

Her vow is: "I will remain a wanderer until mankind has learned the way of peace, walking until I am given shelter and fasting until I am given food."

The pleasant, blue-eyed Peace Pilgrim intends to deliver a message to any who might be interested at Hertz Memorial Hall Wednesday evening.
